Personal Equipment List – Weekend 2

The troop will hike to and from a remote campsite for the second weekend of the course. All personal and patrol gear must be carried in patrol members' backpacks. The Quartermasters will only transport camp chairs to the campsite. Please notify the Course Director as soon as possible if a medical condition or mobility issue will prevent you from hiking.

Required Individual Gear

Group Gear

Provided by Wood Badge 125 Quartermasters

- Stoves for heating water for dishwashing
- Pots for dishwashing
- Dishwashing detergent
- 1 Tarp per Campsite

Provided by Patrols

- Backpacking tents (2 people per tent required)
- Backpacking stoves and fuel (2-3 per patrol)
- Lighter or matches
- Backpacking-sized cooking pots
- Serving utensils, hot pot tongs, pliers, etc.
- Lanterns (battery or propane only)
- Additional Tarp(s) as needed
